

January 2017 updates on the ADA Pre Assessment Service:

The new ADA website is approaching soon, however at present no memberships are available.

How can I access the pre assessment service now?

The ADA pre assessment service is currently available for January 2017 as a non member . The fee is \$120.00. If you would like to take this service up, please email ADA and request an invoice for a non member pre assessment. ADA will then prepare this for you and email you. You can also request this via the ADA text service 0410 850 185

How is the pre assessment delivered presently?

Until the new website is up the pre assessment is delivered to you via email. It is prepared precisely for your child, teen or adult's age group. ADA email the package to you so there is no need to make a face to face appointment.

Where do I presently post the completed pre assessment documents to?

How long do the results take once ADA receive them?

The pre assessment documents are evaluated carefully by trained and highly experienced ADA assessors and takes generally around 3-5 working days. Results will be emailed. You will receive a one page report with results of the pre assessment.

How does the pre assessment differ to the full assessment?

The ADA pre assessment is a valuable and highly recommended first step in identifying dyslexia and many parents and adults only do this stage of assessment. The pre assessment is also a useful tool to check if a full assessment is beneficial.

What is the price of an ADA full assessment should I wish to go to the next step of assessment?

The fee for a full ADA assessment is \$750.00 you can request a fact sheet for further information.

Other useful information when the new 2017 ADA website is up and running on memberships and pre assessments:

The individual membership including one pre assessment will be \$150.00

The family membership including two pre assessments will be \$250.00

The non member pre assessment will remain at \$120.00

The pre assessment service will be easily accessed online once the new ADA website is up.
