

Seeds of Literacy

We invite parents of infants from birth to 6 months to participate in the exciting new 5-year longitudinal 'Seeds of Literacy' study.

In the study we will follow the development of 100 infants, 50 with and 50 without a family history of dyslexia. The results may assist in developing earlier screening and interventions to give all children the best possible start at school.

You may be eligible to participate if:

- » You have an infant aged between birth and 6 months
- » You HAVE a family history of dyslexia OR you are interested in your child's language and reading development.
- » You and your infant are available to be recorded approximately every 6 months over a period of 4½ years from when your child is 6 months up until to 5 years of age.
